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## **Code of Conduct for Students**

## **Preamble:**

The **Student Code of Conduct** serves as a framework of guidelines aimed at fostering and maintaining a positive, respectful, and inclusive learning environment on campus. It outlines the expected behaviors and social norms that contribute to the safety, well-being, and integrity of the campus community. These rules are established by the institution to ensure that all students can engage in their academic and social pursuits in a supportive, healthy, and harmonious setting. Failure to adhere to these guidelines may disrupt the campus community and result in disciplinary measures being taken against those who violate the code.

## **Disciplinary Rules and Regulations**

Students enrolled with the college are expected to maintain highest standard of behavior and discipline on the campus and also during off-campus visits such as field-trips, educational tours, internships etc. Students must be aware that any instance/s of misconduct will call for severe action by the authorities.

1. While on campus, students shall, at all times wear their I-Cards well displayed. They should be able to produce it before any teaching /administrative staff as and when the need arises.

2. Students must be appropriately dressed on the campus. They should keep their attire formal and sport a presentable and decent look. Student should wear uniform on every alternate day i.e. on **Monday, Wednesday and Friday** without fail.

3. Students must maintain a minimum of 75% attendance in theory lectures and 100% attendance in practical to appear for the semester end exam.

4. Students should feel connected to their college and take care of its property. They must avoid damaging any of the facilities provided to them. Writing on desks, benches, or walls, and any kind of damage to the college property, is strongly discouraged.

5. Students should be cautious around electrical installations and avoid damaging any electrical equipment or fittings in classrooms, laboratories, or other areas on campus.

6. Students are responsible for helping to keep the campus clean and attractive. They should avoid littering in classrooms, corridors, staircases, or playgrounds, and ensure that all trash is disposed of in the designated bins. Students are encouraged to be self-disciplined and take responsibility for maintaining cleanliness throughout the campus.
